4. First-aid Measures

SKIN CONTACT: Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention. Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. 6. Accidental Release Measures

PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS : Ventilate closed spaces before entering them. ELIMINATE all ignition sources (no smoking, flares, sparks or flames in immediate area). Keep upwind. Prevent entry into waterways, sewer, basements or confined areas. Stop the flow

of material, if this is without risk. Evacuate spill area and keep unprotected personnel away.

METHODS AND MATERIALS FOR CONTAINMENT AND CLEANUP: Absorb spill with vermiculite or other inert material, then place in a container for chemical waste. Dike far ahead of larger spill for later recovery and disposal. In case of leakage, eliminate all ignition sources. Stop flow if possible.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: Do not contaminate water sources or sewer. Prevent further leakage or spillage if safe to do so. Avoid release to the environment.
